

## LINCOLNSHIRE JUNIOR ANGLING ACADEMY – RULES OF MEMBERSHIP

- 1. All members are to pay their annual subscription and event peg fees as required.
- 2. All members, where applicable, must be in possession of an EA rod licence.
- 3. All members under the age of 11yrs, **MUST** have a family members/ guardian presents at all times.
- 4. Juniors can join the Academy at the age of 8yrs.
- 5. Juniors can join the Academy UNDER the age of 8yrs providing;
  - a) A parent will be present at all times
  - b) That parent is a competent angler in their own right
- 6. Access to all waters and fisheries must only be obtained by indicated routes.
- 7. Baited tackle must not be left unattended either in or out of the water.
- 8. All nets must be of knotless construction and suitable for purpose.
- 9. All fish are to be returned alive to their waters with no exceptions, regardless of any local by-laws.
- 10. LITTER: All members are responsible for removing ANY litter in their swims including surplus bait. Do not leave it on the bank.
- 11. All members will abide by any independent, additional fishery rules applicable to the selected venues booked for events.
- 12. All events will be run in a "match" style format to avoid any peg confrontation, where members will draw their pegs, unless otherwise arranged.
- 13. Foul language and temper out bursts will not be tolerated.

- 14. All members must conduct themselves in a manner that causes no offence or disturbance of other members, anglers, water users and nearby members of the public, so much as reasonably possible.
- 15. Standard Angling Trust match rules will apply to all LJAA events.
- 16.No fish are to purposely come into contact with the ground. Wet nets and unhooking mats are to be used when weighing and for photographic purposes.
- 17. Any members found to be contravening the LJAA rules will be subject to disciplinary action by the LJAA officers.
